Enid Porter says, “Add important information like where it came from, or how old it is”.

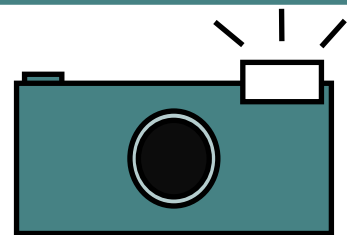
Make a label for your object
